

# Swedish party will enjoy derby game

TOMORROW'S derby game promises to be the highlight of Ipswich Town supporters' season, not least a record number of Swedes coming across just for the match.

Town fan Steve Myers will once again be making the trip as one of the 38-strong group that will also play a friendly game against a 'punch drunk' team of Blues followers on Saturday morning, followed by dinner and a few drinks.

Those up in time in the morning plan a stadium tour at 9.45am, before the lunchtime kick off.

Myers said: "This year it's bigger than ever before, as 38 people are registered to make the trip, beating last year's 25 by a considerable margin.

"Some of them will be first-timers, ie going to their first live ITFC match, while several others are old hands, who have been many times before.

"We have even ordered a special piqué shirt to be printed with the ITFC Sweden logo to mark the event."
